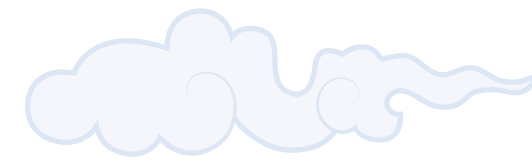

FACTSHEET

LOCATION

Leh nestles at a height of 11,562 ft above sea level in the Himalayas. The Grand Dragon Ladakh is located in the heart of Leh, 4.5 kms from the Leh airport and within walking distance to the bustling market.

GETTING THERE

There are daily flights to Leh from Delhi, Srinagar and Jammu. Additional flights from Chandigarh and Mumbai Leh is also accessible by road during the summer months - April to November from Himachal Pradesh through the Atal Tunnel via the Manali – Leh Highway, 430 kms and from Srinagar in J&K via the Zojila Pass on the Srinagar-Leh road, 434 kms.

ACCOMMODATION

All 76 rooms are modern and elegantly appointed with Ladakhi accents. Each has double glazing, individually controlled central heating and air-conditioning. In addition, to ensure guest comfort in combating low oxygen levels and dry climatic conditions, there are fresh air systems with humidifiers that infuse fresh air and moisture in the rooms. All rooms have LED Satellite TV, in-room electronic safe, en-suite bathrooms with heated flooring, modern fixtures and paraben free amenities and offer stunning views of the picturesque landscape, the vivid colours of an ever-changing sky and the lofty Himalayan peaks.

29 PREMIER HERITAGE ROOMS (300 sqft) [7 twin]: A spacious retreat in both contemporary and traditional style — complete with beautiful Himalayan views.

36 LUXURY ROOMS (350-450 sqft) [12 twin]: Relax in the most spacious Luxury room with enhanced amenities such as a Nespresso machine, larger bathrooms and some with a balcony for your private view of the mountains.

6 HERITAGE SUITES (750 sqft) Ideal for young families as it accommodates two adults and two children. A charming floor seating in the living area can be used as a lounge during the day and as a bed for the children at night.

3 LUXURY SUITE (1280 sqft) A private sanctuary with uninterrupted views of the snow-capped Stok Kangri glacier. These capacious luxury suites come with a master bedroom with an interconnecting living cum dining and a balcony.

1 FAMILY SUITE (1600 sqft) A favourite of Bollywood celebrities, the Family Suite has a master bedroom, an interconnecting living cum dining and a separate twin bedroom with a private balcony.

1 DRAGON SUITE (950 sqft) The Grand Dragon Ladakh's unique Dragon Suite ideal for honeymooners is a charming reflection of a traditional Ladakhi styled studio apartment complete with a ceiling of poplar beams and rafters with willow reeds and antique artifacts. Spectacular Himalayan vistas are a given, where even the bathroom comes with a view.

DINING
